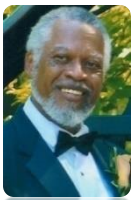

OUR SPIRITUAL GIFTS

By the grace of God, mankind is endowed with spiritual gifts, that we might accomplish the demands of our dominion on earth. These gifts are by necessity diverse, to be used for the needs and support of those with whom we have contact. Although these gifts are given to us, they are not directly for us. They are to be given, allowing God to bless those He will. The guidance of the Holy Ghost is critical. Scripture reveals ***“Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under feet, and turn again and rend you” (Matthew 7:6).*** We need to keep in mind, however, that God causes the rain to fall on the wheat and the tares equally. As we take ownership of our spiritual gifts, evil seeks to corrupt our use of them and we tend to become prideful of them, as though we did something to deserve them, obligating God to anoint us with them. We receive blessings as we provide our gifts to others as God intends. The Apostle Paul pleads with the Romans ***“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect will of God” (Romans 12:1-2).*** Although it is not unto death, these sacrifices for others are in the same spirit that Jesus sacrificed Himself for all mankind. It is the example Christ demonstrated on the Cross of Calvary, for our sins, that inspires the hardest heart to share of itself for the benefit of others. The standards we establish for ourselves must be based on the infinite Word of God, and not on the world’s finite, self-serving, materialism. Our obedience to God’s Word, applied to all aspects of our lives, is justified by its divine nature. Scripture reveals ***“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God” (John 1:1).*** It is inescapably evident that the work of the cross and the inspired Word of God are the most important gifts that Christ and the Holy Spirit have provided us. If we give anything greater importance than commitment and belief in them, we create an idol of it, in violation of Scripture’s command ***“I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shalt have no other gods before me” (Exodus 20:2-3).*** The sacrifices we make perfect and mature us for the glory of eternal life with Christ Jesus.

1. Our Prayers – 1 Timothy 2:1-6

2. Our Presence – Matthew 5:16

Witness everywhere we go through our life, and use words, if necessary.

3. Our Proclamation – Romans 10:13-14; Romans 1:16; Romans 10:17

While prayer is of the utmost importance, there does come a time when we must speak up. Remembering these three things may help: our rebellion (Sin), our ransom (the Cross), and our response (accepting the free gift of Salvation).
